Trustees Meeting of 7th April 2025

The Trustees met after the April coffee morning:

- The meeting agreed the new Safeguarding and Data Protection policies and a new Complaints Procedure for the branch.
- Our Treasurer (Colin O'Brien) reported a healthy balance of £15,197. We agreed that some of this sum should be spent to the benefit of all members and that decisions should be made at a future meeting. Members could suggest ideas for using the money to any of the Trustees.
- We noted that the Railway, Afternoon Tea, Dining Experience and Devon History Groups all needed new leaders. Anybody interested in leading one of these groups should contact Richard Taylor.
- The meeting agreed that the Minutes Secretary need not be a Trustee but could be co-opted by the Chair if s/he wanted to have voting rights. We also agreed to use ballot forms for Officer and Trustee voting at the AGM rather than risk embarrassing candidates by using a show of hands.
- Some Trustees were concerned that members were reserving too many seats at coffee mornings, which made it
 difficult for new members to find somewhere to sit. We all felt that this made the branch seem unwelcoming to new
 members and agreed to encourage members not to reserve too many seats.
